**SUPPLEMENTARY DECISION IN RESPECT OF:
INTERNATIONAL TRADE MARK REGISTRATION
NO. WO0000001814618 DESIGNATING THE UK**

1. On 30 June 2026, I issued my decision (BLO/0558/26) in respect of opposition OP453485.

2. Following receipt of email correspondence from the Opponent's representative, Corinna Hiscox, on 8 July 2026, it came to light that International Registration No. WO0000001814618, which was contested in the above-mentioned opposition, had already been refused in its entirety following the issue of decision BLO/0203/26 in respect of fast track proceedings OP600003659 on 12 March 2026.

3. An email was sent to the parties on 13 July 2026, confirming that the application had been refused in its entirety following the issue of decision BLO/0203/26 on 12 March 2026, which pre-dated the issue of decision BLO/0558/26 on 30 June 2026. The parties were also informed that decision BLO/0558/26 had been removed from the website and that the matter would be investigated further.

4. Following a review of the matter, it has been confirmed that the application was refused in its entirety following the issue of decision BLO/0203/26 on 12 March 2026. No appeal was lodged against that decision and, accordingly, the application remained refused in its entirety. The IPO notified WIPO on 24 April 2026 that the refusal was confirmed for all goods and services. It was determined that decision BLO/0558/26 had subsequently been issued in error, and that this administrative error amounted to a procedural irregularity.

5. This supplementary decision corrects the procedural irregularity. It confirms that the application was refused in its entirety following the issue of decision BLO/0203/26 on 12 March 2026, and that decision BLO/0558/26 was issued in error. Accordingly, decision BLO/0558/26 is set aside and is to have no effect.
