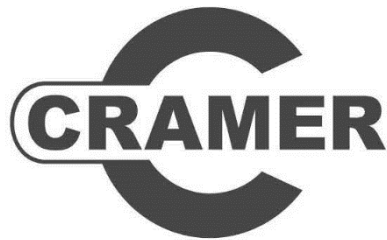

1. On 18 June 2024, I issued a decision (O/0559/24) in the above referenced proceedings.
2. It has been brought to my attention that, in listing the goods for which the opposition has succeeded at paragraph 72 in the original decision, the first term that I listed in Class 12, i.e. "Vehicles for locomotion by land, air, water or rail" was wrong. In the body of the decision, I had found that vehicles for locomotion by land were *Meric* identical to the opponent's goods, but that vehicles for locomotion by air, water or rail were dissimilar. Consequently, the first term listed in Class 12 at paragraph 72 should have said "Vehicles for locomotion by land".
3. I regard the above as an irregularity in procedure and capable of being corrected under Rule 74(1) of the Trade Marks Rules 2008. Consequently, this supplementary decision corrects that error such that paragraph 72 of the original decision reads as follows:

"72. Subject to appeal, the opposition has succeeded in relation to the following goods, for which the application is refused:

Class 7 Snow blowers; Snow throwers.

Class 12 Vehicles for locomotion by land; Tractors; Cars; Motor cars; Cleaning cart; Engines for land vehicles; Motor for land vehicles; Transmissions motor, for land vehicles; Transmissions, for land vehicles; Propulsion device for land vehicles; Seats for land vehicles; Motorcycles; Upholstery for vehicles; Rearview mirrors; Side cars; Motorcycle wheel; Motorcycle wheel axis holder; Bicycle; Electric bicycle; Motor tricycle; Electro-tricycle; Moped; Wheelchairs; Convey carts; Golf carts; Carts; Wheelbarrows; Tires for vehicle wheels; none of the aforesaid being skidders, loading vehicles, lifting vehicles, wheel loaders, mobile telescopic loaders."

4. The appeal period will be reset and will now start from the date of this supplementary decision.
